ORDER

In the letter read above the Executive Chairman & Director, Information Kerala Mission has furnished a proposal for providing VPN connectivity through BSNL to the local bodies which are not directly connected to KSWAN. The rates offered by BSNL are as follows:

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to provide VPN connectivity on the rates offered by BSNL, to all the local bodies in the state where KSWAN connectivity is not available. The Information Kerala Mission is appointed as the Nodal Agency for providing connectivity.

Instead of submitting separate requests for connectivity to BSNL by the local bodies, the Information Kerala Mission will take necessary steps to connect the local bodies to broadband VPN to avoid the delay in implementation

The Information Kerala Mission will also sign a detailed Service Level Agreement with BSNL to ensure 100% uptime connectivity during office hours.


