Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has launched new scheme Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2014. The scheme aim to translate the concept of Gram Swaraj into reality through effective implementation of scheme to achieve the main objective of (i) holistic development of the identified Gram Panchayat (ii) Improving the standard of living & quality of life of all sections of the population (iii) Generating models of local level development & effective local governance which can motivate and inspire neighbouring gram Panchayat to learn & adapt (iv) To nurture the identified Aadarsh Grams as schools of local development to train other gram Panchayats.

In order to achieve the above objectives the Member of Parliament will lead and guide their constituencies. The District Collector/District Magistrates will be the nodal officers at the District level. The scheme require planned co ordination and convergence among different Government departments while leveraging people's participation and strength of the community at the village level. The MP will identify one Gram Panchayat to be taken for transformation into Adarsh gram by 2016. To implement the scheme in the state the following instructions are issued:-

- 1.District Collector in consultation with respective MP/MLA should identify/select Gram panchayat in accordance with the guideline of SAGY
2. All the District Collectors are requested to get in touch with MP and upload the details in the web site [pmusaanji@gov.in](mailto:pmusaanji@gov.in)
3. Name of the Gram Panchayat selected can be e-mailed to the e-mail ID [pmusaanji@gov.in](mailto:pmusaanji@gov.in)
4. A senior officers from Rural Development Department nominated for the purpose will be the nodal officer for SAGY
5. A State team of Trainers (STOT) at rate 1 STOT for 5MPs (total 29

MPs and there fore 6STOTS)will be selected

6. Retired Senior Officer from State Department may be posted as STOT on voluntary basis. They will paid TA and DA.

7. Administrative cost allowed under Rural Development programme like MGNREGA, NRLM, IAY, NSAP etc. can be utilized for organizing capacity building Programmes and for meeting the TA,DA of the STOTS.

8. District Collector will be the Nodal Officer for implementing SAGY at district level.

The Commissioner for Rural Development and Director of Panchayat and all District Collectors are given direction to take necessary action for implementing the scheme SAGY as per the condition depicted in the guidelines (uploaded on [www.saanjhi.gov.in](http://www.saanjhi.gov.in)) and also to keep time line prescribed in the guideline.
