Abstract-Power Department-Incentives to Industries-Guidelines issued.

Read.- G.O.(Ms.) No. 4/92/PD, dated 6th February 1992.

ORDER

In the light of the statement of Industrial Policy approved for implementation by Government various incentives in respect of Electricity have been ordered in the Government Order read above. It is considered necessary that incentives to be extended to all Industrial establishments irrespective of their size and type of consumption (LT/HT/EHT) for conservation of energy. Government are, therefore, pleased to order that all industrial establishments will be granted rebate in tariff for achieving savings in Specific Energy Consumption (SEC), as per following scale:

	<i>Percentage saving in Specific Energy Consumption</i>		<i>Rebate</i>
	0-15 percent	Nil	
Over	5-20 Percent	5 p/kwh	
Over	10-20 percent	8 p/kwh	
Over	20 percent	10 p/kwh	

2. The rebate will be payable subject to the conditions and procedure laid here under.

(i) Total energy saving should not be less than 10,000 kwh on actual production for the year in the financial year of which claim is put up. This must be in addition to the requirement of minimum saving in S.E.C.

(ii) The year for which the 1st claim of rebate is made will be called 'zero year'.

(iii) The comparison of S.E.C. and energy consumption in the zero year will be made with the average of S.E.C. and total energy consumption with the three preceding financial years (bench marks).

(iv) Rebate will be available for a period of three years provided that:

(a) the saving in S.E.C. and total energy consumption is not less than that in the zero year;

(b) in case the saving in any subsequent years falls in higher slab with reference to bench mark, correspondingly higher rebate will be admissible;

(Eg: If a unit saves over 5 per cent energy in zero year, 11 per cent in the next year and 21 per cent in the third year, it will be entitled to receive rebate at the rate of 5 ps. inn the zero year, 8 ps. in the 1st year and 10

3. Kerala State Electricity Board will issue a Board Order prescribing detailed procedure, application form etc. for grant of rebate.
