**ORDER**

Smt.C.M.Lakshmi, D/o.late. C.K.Mohanan, who died in harness on 01/05/2003 while working as Upper Division Clerk in the O/o the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam District applied for employment assistance under Compassionate Employment Scheme. The deceased Government servant put in a total service of 15 years 08 months and 10 days.

The applicant is 20 years old as her date of birth being 04/07/1994. She has passed SSLC & Plus 2 Examinations. The request is for the appointment in the post of Lower Division Clerk and she is qualified for that post.

The Director of Panchayats and the District Collector, Ernakulam as per the letters read as 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> papers above have recommended the request of Smt.C.M.Lakshmi. All the legal heirs of the deceased have also relinquished their claims in favour of the applicant and have given their consent statements. The applicant is a real dependent of the deceased. None of the dependents of the deceased has applied for availing the benefit under the scheme earlier. No other family members of the applicant have got appointment under the Scheme.

The District Collector, Ernakulam as per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above has reported that the annual family income of the deceased Government Servant is Rs.4,24,080/- (Rupees Four lakh Twenty four thousand and eighty only).

In the above circumstances, sanction is accorded to the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam to appoint Smt.C.M.Lakshmi, D/o.late. C.K.Mohanan, Upper Division Clerk, the O/o the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam District in the existing/arising vacancy of Lower Division Clerk in Ernakulam District under Compassionate Employment Scheme, subject to the conditions laid down in the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above after verifying all the original certificates.

The Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam shall make necessary entries in the Service Book of the deceased Government employee and in the Establishment Register, regarding grant of employment to the dependent as stipulated in the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above.

The employment assistance under the scheme will be cancelled if and when it is found that there is any misrepresentation or suppression of material facts on the part of the incumbent during the course of enquiry conducted by various Government agencies.
