### ORDER

As proposed by **Sri.I.C.Balakrishnan, MLA representing Sulthan Bathery Constituency** under LAC-ADS for the year 2014-15 as per the reference read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Chief Engineer, PWD, Buildings, Thiruvananthapuram has furnished detailed estimate of the work '**Construction of Heritage Museum at Kalloor in Noolpuzha Grama Panchayat**' at an estimate cost of **Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lac only)** as per the reference read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above to accord Administrative Sanction and Special Sanction.
