ORDER

As per the G.O read as 2nd paper above, SERIFED was liquidated and the employees were redeployed to Local Self Government Department. The said G.O also stipulated that all pending cases under Compassionate Employment Scheme in the SERIFED will be processed in Commissionerate of Rural Development and Local Self Government Department as per existing rules. Smt. Lekshmi Lenin, D/o K.D.Latha, Field Assistant, Serifed Ernakulam District Office who died in harness on 29/9/2007 while working as Field Assistant, Serifed Ernakulam District Office applied for employment assistance under Compassionate Employment Scheme. The deceased Government servant put in a total service of 11 years 9 months and 9 days.

The applicant is 25 years old, as her date of birth being 18/3/1990. She has passed Plus two Examination. The request is for appointment to the post of Lower Division Clerk and she is qualified for that post.

The Director of Panchayats and the District Collector, Alappuzha as per the letters read as 4th and 5th papers above respectively have recommended the request of Smt. Lekshmi Lenin. All the legal heirs of the deceased have also relinquished their claims in favour of the applicant and have given their consent statements. The applicant is a real dependent of the deceased. None of the dependents of the deceased has applied for availing the benefit under the scheme earlier. No other family members of the applicant have got appointment under the Scheme.

The District Collector, Alappuzha as per the letter read as 4th paper above has reported that the annual family income of the deceased Government servant is ₹1.08,000/- (Rupees One Lakh and Eight Thousand only).

In the above circumstances, sanction is accorded to the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam to appoint Smt.Lekshmi Lenin, D/o Late K.D.Latha, Field Assistant, Serifed Ernakulam District Office, (Aswathi, Parayil Bhagam, Pattanakkad P.O. Alappuzha) in the existing/arising vacancy of Lower Division Clerk in Ernakulam District under Compassionate Employment Scheme, subject to the conditions laid down in the Government Order read as 1st paper above and subsequent Government Orders, after verifying all the original certificates.

The Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam shall make necessary entries in the Service Book of the deceased Government employee and in the Establishment Register, regarding grant of employment to the dependent as stipulated in the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

The employment assistance under the scheme will be cancelled if and when it is found that there is any misrepresentation or suppression of material facts on the part of the incumbent during the course of enquiry conducted by various Government agencies.


