The Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Government of India as per letter read as first paper above had specified the activities on which upto 10% of the Fourteenth Finance Commission Grants can be utilized by the Local Governments.

In pursuance to the above instructions, the High Level Monitoring Committee in its meeting held on 09/05/2016 decided to utilize 3% of the total allocation of Basic Grant for Social Audit etc.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that upto 3% of the Basic Grant shall be utilized by the Rural Local Governments and Urban Local Governments for cost of Social Audit and cost of preparation of technical plan for implementation of projects like solid and liquid waste management and drinking water.
