ORDER

The Vigilance and Anti Corruption Bureau has conducted a surprise check at Thrikkakkara Grama Panchayat and submitted report as per 1st paper read above. The following irregularities were pointed out in the report.

1. M/S Trinity Archade Pvt. Ltd has constructed a cellar for car parking, without the approval of the Panchayath.
2. NOC Register was not maintained in the Panchayat.

Departmental action was suggested against Sri. T.S. Subhash and Sri. Mohammed Nadir, former Secretaries of Thrikkakkara Grama Panchayat on the basis of the above allegations.

Government has sought a detailed report from the Deputy Director of Panchayat and Director of Panchayats vide the papers read as 2nd and 3rd respectively. The detailed report received from the Director of Panchayats and Deputy Director of Panchayats vide papers read as 4th and 5th respectively.

It has been reported that one of the officers Sri. Mohammed Nadir, against whom disciplinary action was recommended by the Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau had passed away. Another accused officer in the Vigilance report Sri. Subhash was not included either in the report of the Director of Panchayats or of the Deputy Director of Panchayat. Sri. Subhash had retired from service on 31/5/2006. It has been again reported that the construction of the said building was regularised by accepting a compounding fee of Rs. 19,16,100/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Sixteen Thousand and Hundred only).

After examining the matter in detail Government have decided to drop the disciplinary proceedings initiated against Sri. T.S. Subhash and late Mohammed Nadir former Secretaries of Thrikkakkara Grama Panchayat. The Director of Panchayats will take necessary action in this matter.
