**ORDER**

The Judicial First Class Majistrate I, Alappuzha as per its order read as 1<sup>st</sup> above had sentenced Sri. T. Thilakan, former U.D Clerk, Muhamma Grama Panchayath and another to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 2 years and for a fine of Rs.2000 for offences punishable u/s 324 r/w 34 IPC.

He was suspended from service as per the proceedings read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above and as per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above, the case was referred to government for continuing action under Rule 18 of KCS (CC&A) Rules 1960. Accordingly Government have tentatively decided to remove Sri. T. Thilakan, former UD Clerk, Muhamma Grama Panchayath from Service as per Rule 18 of the Kerala Civil Service (CC&A) Rules 1960. A Show Cause notice to this effect was served to the incumbent as per the paper read as 4<sup>th</sup> above. In response to this Sri.T.Thilakan submitted a written statement of defence as per the paper read as 5<sup>th</sup> above stating that the decision to remove him from service is illegal and

unjust. He also requested to wait till the final verdict of the court in the criminal appeal filed by him.

After examining the written statement of defence of the incumbent, the Government had decided to continue with the tentative decision and the advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission was sought for as per the paper read as 6<sup>th</sup> above. The Kerala Public Service Commission Commission agreed with the tentative decision of the government to remove Sri. Thilakan from service as per the letter read as 7<sup>th</sup> above.

After examining the matter in detail in the light of the proposal of the Director of Panchayats, Written Statement of Defence submitted by Sri. Thilakan and the advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission, the Government have decided to finalise the tentative decision to remove Sri. T. Thilakan, former U.D. Clerk, Muhamma Grama Panchayath, Alappuzha under Rule 18 of the Kerala Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 1960 with effect from the date of his suspension from service and order accordingly. The Director of Panchayats will take further necessary action in the matter.
