ORDER

As per the Judgment read as 1st paper above the Hon'ble Enquiry Commissioner & Special Judge, Thrissur has convicted Sri. K. N. Narayanan, former Secretary, Mukkannoor Grama Panchayat under various sections of IPC and Prevention of corruption Act. Hon'ble Court sentenced him to undergo two years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs. 14,175/- in default 3 more month rigorous imprisonment u/s 13 (1) (c) 13(1) (d) r/w 13(2) of prevention of corruption Act 1988, one year rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs.1000/- and in default, one more month rigorous imprisonment u/s 409, 468, 471 and 477 of IPC and six months rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs. 1000/- and in default, one more month rigorous imprisonment under Sec. 120 (B) of IPC on the proved charges. The substantive sentence shall run concurrently. It was also specified in the order that a loss of an amount of Rs.28,345/- is sustained on the part of Sri. K.N. Narayanan.

The Officer retired on superannuation. Hence a tentative decision of deduction of pension of Rs.500/- p.m for five years has been initiated and advice of Kerala Public Service Commission has been sought for. The Commission agreed to the tentative decision and further suggested to initiate steps to recover an amount of Rs.28345/-from Sri.K.N Narayanan towards the loss sustained to Government. Considering the advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission tentative decision of pension deduction is confirmed and orders issued as per 2nd paper read above.

Government have examined the matter in detail. As per rule, the loss sustained to Government may be recovered from the DCRG if the same is intimated with in the time limit prescribed in Note 3 below rule 3 Part III KSR. If the same cannot be recovered from DCRG and if the amount to be recovered is comparatively less, the loss sustained can be

recovered from DR portion of pension or its arrears. In this circumstances from the options available under the rule loss of Rs.28,345/- shall be recovered from the DR portion of pension and its arrears of Sri. K.N. Narayanan retired Panchayat Secretary and order accordingly. The Director of Panchayats shall take necessary action in this matter.
