Local Self Government Department - Goshree Islands Development Authority –Mulavukad Road Widening Project Phase II- Tender excess approved and revised administrative sanction accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER

Mulavukad Road Widening Project is envisaged for the widening of the 5.5 km long road from Mulavukad to Goshree road to a width of 7m. The first phase of the project covering 2.5kms from Mulavukad northern end up to navy land has been completed and open to traffic. The second phase of the project covers 1.5kms from Navy Land to Tandassery. Government, vide GO read as 2nd paper above accorded administrative sanction to the Mulavukad Road Widening Project- Phase II for an amount of Rs.2,10,99,384/- against the original proposal of Rs.2,23,72,631/-. The Technical Sanction for the above work was issued by the Harbour Engineering Department for an amount of ₹ 2,05,30,000/-.

2. For and on behalf of GIDA, KITCO invited e-tenders for this work and considering the site condition KITCO recommended to award the work to M/s. Friends Constructions, Perumbavoor at their reduced quoted amount of ₹ 2,23,06,076/-. Hence the Secretary, Goshree Islands Development Authority, vide letter read above submitted revised proposal for according administrative sanction for Mulavukad Road Widening Project - Phase II for an amount of ₹ 2,42,00,000/- (including consultancy charge of KITCO & GST thereon) as well as for accepting the tender of M/s. Friends Construction, Perumbavoor and informed that the re tendering of the said work is not feasible citing the reason that the site is in a water logged area.

3. As per the G.O read as 1st paper above, the maximum tender excess admissible shall be limited either to the quoted rate of the lowest bidder or local market rate or current DSR plus 10% tolerance limit whichever is less. Accordingly the maximum admissible contract amount is ₹ 2,05,72,995/-. But on negotiation, the bidder is not agreeable to the maximum admissible contract amount of ₹ 2,05,72,995/- and was willing to reduce the amount by ₹ 50,000/- only from ₹ 2,23,06,076/ -

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the tender excess in respect of Mulavukad Road Widening Project - Phase II, being implemented by the Goshree Islands Development Authority, at the negotiated amount of ₹ 2,22,56,076/- (Two Crore Twenty Two Lakhs Fifty Six Thousand and Seventy Six Only) by waiver of the stipulations contained in the G.O read as 1st paper above as a special case and accordingly revised administrative sanction is also accorded for a total amount of ₹ 2,39,52,000/- (Two Crore Thirt Nine Lakhs Fify Two Thousand Only) inclusive of the consultancy charge of ₹ 14,37,100/- and GST @18% thereon amounting to ₹ 2,58,678/- subject to the condition that the expenditure for the project shall be met from the fund of GIDA.


