#### <u>ORDER</u>

Suchitwa Keralam (Urban) and Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) are the plan schemes of Suchitwa Mission. An amount of Rs 2233 lakh has been earmarked for Suchitwa Keralam (Urban) under the H/A - 2217-80-800-71 and an amount of Rs 3500 lakh has been earmarked for Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) under the H/A-2515-00-101-68, for the implementation of plan schemes of Sucitwa Mission for the yaear 2020-2021.

2. As per the letter read as  $1^{st}$  paper above, Executive Director, Suchitwa Mission has requested to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs 2233 lakh for Suchitwa Keralam (Urban) under the H/A – 2217-80-800-71 and an amount of Rs 3500 lakh for Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) under the H/A – 2515-00-101-68.

3. Pre monsoon Cleaning Campaign is one of the components of the Plan Schemes of Suchitwa Mission for the year 2020-2021 i.e. Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) and Suchitwa Keralam (Urban), with financial outlay of **Rs.1597 lakh and Rs.395** lakh respectively. Considering the outbreak of COVID-19 and the onset of Monsoon, Administrative Sanction has been accorded to the Pre-monsoon Cleaning Campaign Component of Plan Schemes of Suchitwa Mission for the year 2020-2021, i.e. Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) and Suchitwa Keralam (Urban), for an amount of **Rs.1321 lakh and Rs.363 lakh** respectively, as per G.O read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above.

4. As per the minutes read as  $3^{rd}$  paper above, Special Working Group (SWG) for plan schemes held on 01.07.2020 has approved the plan scheme of Suchitwa Mission for the year **2020-2021**, subject to the condition that expenditure under Suchitwa Keralam Waste Management Scheme (Rural & Urban) should be limited to available budget provision of **Rs**. **18.79 Cr and 16.70 Cr** respectively.

5. Government have examined the matter in detail and are are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the implementation of Annual Plan Schemes of Suchitwa Mission for the year 2020-2021- Suchitwa Keralam (Rural) and Suchitwa Keralam (Urban), for an amount of Rs. 1879 lakh and 1670 lakh respectively as detailed below:

The funds will be released directly to Local Bodies by State Mission through allocation system and monitoring will be done through District Suchitwa Missions. There will be flexibility in Physical Target, as it is based on the demand from local bodies. Period of Implementation of project will be from **April 2020 to March 2021**.

7. With the implementation of the project Source level treatment of waste at households level, institution level and community level will be promoted and sustainable waste management models will be set up in Government Institutions, markets, residential areas etc. A clean environment in Kerala is the expected outcome of the implementation of the project
