ORDER

Sri. Kumar and Others filed OA (Ekm) No.1100/2021 before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, Ernakulam seeking the benefit of reemployment as granted to the beneficiaries of the Government order read as 10th paper above and Hon'ble Tribunal as per the order read as 11th paper above directed as follows:-

"....permitting the applicants to move the second respondent in appropriate representations seeking the benefits as granted to the beneficiaries of

GO(MS)No.56/2021, within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. On receipt of such representation along with the copy of this order the 2nd respondent shall consider the same in accordance with law taking note of Annexure A12 order G.O (MS) No.56/2021 issued granting the benefits to similarly placed persons and issue orders thereon within a period of 2 months therefrom."

- 2) Subsequently, the petitioners submitted a representation before Government read as 12th paper above requesting to appoint them in Local Self Government / Forest Department as done in Government order read as 10th paper above, wherein Government have accorded sanction for the reemployment of 32 employees of erstwhile AHADS belonging to ST category.
- 3) Based on the representation read as 12 th paper above, Government sought the report of Director General KILA. As per letter read as 13 th paper above, Director General, KILA has informed that the activities of AHADS came to an end by 31/03/2012 as per letter No. 21158/1B1/2012/LSGD dated 31/03/2012. After that it was registered as society namely AHADS -CCPRM as per G.O. read as 6th paper above. As per 7th paper above AHADS -CCPRM was dissolved and merged unconditionally to KILA. It was also reported that the applicants were engaged as Environmental Literacy Instructors (except Sri. Kumar. R) and the instruction / guidelines issued to the Environmental Literacy Instructors as per order No. 3499/WD/2004 dated 29/04/2005 of Project Director, erstwhile AHADS. The first applicant Mr. Kumar R., has worked in the capacity of General Volunteer / Technical Assistant till 2010. As per the report the time frame of association of the petitioners with AHADs is as follows:

- 4) Government have examined the matter in detail. As per G.O read as 10th paper above, only those employees of AHADS belonging to ST category who have continued in AHADS till its winding up have been re-employed by Government towards newly created Supernumerary posts. The petitioners have worked for a short period and quit their jobs in AHADS before its winding up.
- 5) In the above circumstances, the claim of the petitioners for the benefit of re-employment as granted to the beneficiaries of the Government order read as 10th paper above does not deserve any merit and hence it is hereby rejected.
- 6) The direction contained in the Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 11th paper above is complied with accordingly.
