ORDER

The 34th SHPSC has considered the proposal of Kannur Municipal Corporation for Administrative Sanction for the new Water Supply Sector work, “Pipeline Extension & providing water connections in various zones of Kannur Corporation – Phase II”, under AMRUT 1.0. Based on the recommendation of 29th SLTC of AMRUT as per the minutes read as 1st paper above, 34th SHPSC has decided to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.24.34 Cr. for the new Water Supply sector work, “Pipeline Extension & providing water connections in various zones of Kannur Corporation – Phase II”, subject to the following conditions:

- The amount required (Rs.24.34 Cr.) shall be met from the savings available (Rs.1.455 Cr.) in the completed works in the SWD, UT and PRK sectors, the savings available (Rs.3.857 Cr.) in the SEW sector work, ‘Providing decentralized sewerage network with STP in old Kannur Municipal area’, and the balance amount Rs.19.028 Cr.) shall be met from the savings transferred to the SEW sector of the Thiruvananthapuram Corporation as per the decision (no.4.1) of the 31st SHPSC
- Any financial implication due to non-completion of the work by March-2024 shall be borne by the ULB.

2. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, Mission Director, AMRUT has requested to accord Administrative Sanction for new Water Supply sector

work, “Pipeline Extension & providing water connections in various zones of Kannur Corporation – Phase II” based on the decision of 34th SHPSC.

3. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.24.34 Cr. for the new Water Supply Sector work, “Pipeline Extension & providing water connections in various zones of Kannur Corporation – Phase II”, subject to the following conditions:

- The amount required (Rs.24.34 Cr.) shall be met from the savings available (Rs.1.455 Cr.) in the completed works in the SWD, UT and PRK sectors, the savings available (Rs.3.857 Cr.) in the SEW sector work, ‘Providing decentralized sewerage network with STP in old Kannur Municipal area’, and the balance amount of Rs.19.028 Cr. shall be met from the savings transferred to the SEW sector of the Thiruvananthapuram Corporation as per the decision (no.4.1) of the 31st SHPSC
