ORDER

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Govt of India had conveyed sanction for release of an amount of Rs.10,00,00,000 (Rupees Ten Crore Only) to Govt of Kerala under reform incentive component of AMRUT 2.0 For Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation for under taking projects mentioned below:

- i. Property Tax Mapping through Drone Based Survey/other latest technologies
- ii. Drainage Planning & Water Conservation measures including urban flood prevention
- iii. Reduction in non-revenue water (Introduction of smart elements)
- iv. Mechanized Sewage/Septage cleaning

v.Drinking water outlets in public areas

2. As per G.O read as 1st paper above, sanction has been accorded for the release of an amount of Rs.10,00,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Crore Only) under the Head of Account 2217-05-191-48(34) to provide the Central assistance under reform incentive component for Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation under AMRUT 2.0.

3. As per the minutes read as 2nd paper above, the 8th SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 had instructed (decision 8.9) the Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority and the Secretary Thiruvananthapuram Corporation to submit the proposals for the following purposes

- Property Tax Mapping through Drone Based Survey/Other latest technologies.
- Reduction in Non-Revenue Water (introduction of Smart Elements).
- Mechanized Sewage/Septage cleanings equipment.

4. As per the minutes read as 3rd paper above, the 9th SHPSC has directed Principal Secretary, LSGD to convene a meeting with the Secretary, Water Resources, Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority, Managing Director, AMRUT and the Secretary, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation for finalizing the utilization of Central assistance under reform incentive component for Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation under AMRUT 2.0

5. As per the minutes of the meeting Chaired by Principal Secretary, read as 4th paper above, it was decided to utilize Rs. 10 crore allocated to the Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation under the reform incentive component of AMRUT 2.0 in the ratio of 50:50 for Storm Water Drainage projects including flood prevention in the cities of the Corporation and for the implementation of the project under the Reduction in non-revenue water component by the Kerala Water Authority. The Mayor, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation has informed that, they are not in a position to share the reform incentive with KWA. The 10th SHPSC has considered the matter and based on the recommendation of SLTC, as per the minutes read as 5th paper above, 10th SHPSC has decided that,

- 75% of the incentive amount may be allocated for Drainage Planning and Water Conservation measures including urban flood prevention.
- 25% of the incentive amount may be allocated for property Tax Mapping through Drone Based Survey/Other latest technologies and Reduction in Non-Revenue Water (Introduction of Smart Elements) of

Thiruvananthapuram Corporation.

6. As per the letter read as 6th paper above, the Mission Director, AMRUT has requested to accord sanction based on the decision of 10th SHPSC

7. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord sanction for the utilization of an amount of Rs.10,00,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Crore Only) released towards the Central assistance under reform incentive component for Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation under AMRUT 2.0, as detailed below;

- 75% of the incentive amount shall be allocated for Drainage Planning and Water Conservation measures including urban flood prevention.
- 25% of the incentive amount shall be allocated for property Tax Mapping through Drone Based Survey/Other latest technologies and Reduction in Non-Revenue Water (Introduction of Smart Elements) of Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation
