ORDER

As per the G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, sanction has been accorded for the setting up of Centralized Solid Waste-to-Energy (WtE) Plants at seven identified sites in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Palakkad, Thrissur, Kozhikode, Malappuram and Kannur Districts on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis in Public Private Partnership mode. KSIDC was designated as the Nodal Agency for the setting up of the Waste-to-Energy Plants in collaboration with the Concessionaire and Local Self Government Institutions, float the RFP, select the Concessionaire and execute the Concession Agreement.

2. As per the G.O. read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above Government had accorded sanction for the revised project structure for the Waste-to-Energy projects with Tipping fee as bidding criteria and approved the bidding document. Subsequently as per the directions of the State Level Advisory Committee (SLAC) on Solid Waste Management chaired by Chief Secretary, global tender for identifying suitable private implementing agencies for the setting up of Waste-to-Energy projects at Kollam, Kannur and Palakkad Districts were floated by KSIDC in January 2019. considering the request of prospective bidders the last date for the submission of bids was extended upto 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 in two spells. Even after repeated extension no bids were received for the above three projects. The scenario was reported in the 26<sup>th</sup> meeting of State Level Advisory Committee on Waste Management held on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2019 and SLAC directed to re-tender the three projects with adequate publicity.

Accordingly re-tender for Kollam, Kannur and Palakkad Waste-to-Energy projects was floated by KSIDC in June 2019 and 16<sup>th</sup> August 2019 was the last date for the submission of bids.

3. Consortium of M/s. Organic Recycling Systems Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai and M/s Blue Planet Environment Solutions India Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi were submitted bids for Kannur and Palakkad projects and no bids received for Kollam project. The technical bid submitted by the Consortium for Kannur and Palakkad projects opened and evaluated based on the pre-qualification criteria detailed in the RFP document. The Bid Evaluation Committee, constituted as per the G.O. read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, has carried out the detailed technical evaluation of the technical bids on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. The Bid Evaluation Committee reviewed the technical proposal submitted by the Consortium of M/s. Organic Recycling Systems Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai and M/s Blue Planet Environment Solutions India Pvt. Ltd. New Delhi and found the Consortium of M/s. Organic Recycling Systems Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai as technically qualified. The Committee has therefore resolved to open the financial bid submitted by Consortium of M/s. Organic Recycling Systems Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai.

4. The financial bid submitted by the Consortium of M/s. Organic Recycling Systems Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai was opened on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 in e-tender portal. As per the financial bid submitted Rs.3800/- per tonne and Rs. 3900/- per tonne were the Tipping Fee quoted by the Consortium for Kannur and Palakkad Waste-to-Energy projects respectively. The 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of SLAC resolved to accept the technically qualified bid received through re-tender and authorized the Managing Director, KSIDC to negotiate with the bidder to bring down the Tipping Fee to the extend possible. Based on the two rounds of negotiation so held, the Consortium offered the revised Tipping Fee of Rs.3600/- per tonne and Rs.3800/- per tonne for Kannur and Palakkad Waste-to-Energy projects respectively.

5. The 30<sup>th</sup> meeting of SLAC on Waste Management chaired by Chief Secretary noted the revised offer and resolved to conduct one more round of negotiation at the level of Chairman, SLAC. Based on the final negotiation, the Consortium offered a final offer of Rs. 3550/- per tonne for Kannur WtE project and Rs. 3590/- per tonne for Palakkad WtE project. The 31<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the State Level Advisory Committee chaired by the Chief Secretary resolved to approve the same as final Tipping Fee for Kannur and Palakkad projects. The Managing Director KSIDC as per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper has requested Government to approve the final Tipping Fee of Rs. 3550/- per tonne for Kannur WtE project and Rs. 3590/- per tonne for Palakkad project.

6. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the Tipping Fee of Rs. 3550/- per tonne for Kannur WtE project and 3590/- per tonne for Palakkad WtE projects.
