#### **ORDER**

As per the G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above Government had approved the project of M/s.G.J.Nature Care Consorsium submitted by KITCO for the implementation of a Waste-to-Energy Project at Brahmapuram, Kochi and allied areas at a total cost of Rs. 295 Crore subject to the condition that if the rate of power tariff of the energy produced from the waste treatment plant at Brahmapuram is higher than the average rate fixed by the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission then the additional will be provided as subsidy.

2. The Director, M/s G.J.Eco Power Pvt. Ltd. as per letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above has informed that, the company requires the mechanism for payment to meet the expenses over and above the power tariff fixed by Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission to overcome the hurdles for

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achieving the financial closure. The 19<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Level Advisory Committee on Waste Management held on 22.11.2018 has directed Local Self Government Department to examine and formulate a mechanism for payment to meet the expenses over and above the power tariff to M/s G.J.Eco Power Pvt. Ltd. and issue necessary orders.

- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order as follows.
  - i. 25% of the expenses over and above the average power tariff fixed by Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission for the energy produced from the Waste-to- Energy Plant at Brahmapuram shall be paid to the Concessionaire by Government from the Major Infrastructure Development Scheme and the remaining 75 % by Kochi Municipal Corporation by way of collection of user fee from households / institutions / participating LSGIs / utilizing 15% of the plan fund to be set apart compulsorily for waste management / by locating other means etc.
  - ii. M/s.G.J.Eco Power Pvt. Ltd. shall achieve the financial closure within 30 days from the date of this order, failing which necessary action will be initiated to terminate the Concession Agreement in accordance with the relevant clauses therein.
