ORDER

The 23rd SHPSC of AMRUT held on 04/02/2020 had considered the proposal for tender excess & revision of AS for the work, "Multi Level Car Parking (MLCP) Complex at Stadium Premises & Bank Road" being implemented by Kannur Corporation and decided to finalise the rate of the tender excess of and above tendered PAC based on the report of Chief Engineer, LSGD.

- 2. The Chief Engineer, LSGD has reported that Kannur MLCP consists of two works at different location resulting in additional expenditure in various components. Hence the cost per unit is higher in Kannur compared to Other MLCPs.
- 3. Administrative Sanction was accorded for the project under Urban Transport (UT) Sector as per G.O read as $1^{\rm st}$ paper above,.

TS Amount - Rs.9.258 Cr.

Tendered PAC - Rs.8.84 Cr.

Tender Excess (reduced rate) - Rs.0.707 Cr. (8% above tendered PAC)

4. The 24th SHPSC of AMRUT held on 27/05/2020 accepted the report

from Chief Engineer, LSGD and approved the tender excess of 8% above the tendered PAC and accorded sanction to issue Revised Administrative sanction for Rs 9,96,47,672/-

As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the Mission Director, AMRUT has informed that additional fund requirement shall be met from the savings in the work "Construction of new footpath with handrails" under UT sector in Kannur Corporation and has requested to grant approval for tender excess and issue revised Administrative sanction for Rs 9,96,47,672/-
- 6. Government have examined the matter in detail based on the decision taken in the 24th SHPSC of AMRUT held on 27/05/2020 and are pleased to approve tender excess of 8% above the tendered PAC for the project, "Multi Level Car Parking (MLCP) Complex at Stadium Premises & Bank Road being implemented by Kannur Corporation and accord revised Administrative sanction for the project for Rs 9,96,47,672/-, subject to the condition that the additional fund requirement shall be met from the savings in the work "Construction of new footpath with handrails" under UT sector in Kannur Corporation,
