ORDER

Government vide Order read as 3rd paper above had given Administrative Sanction of Rs. 266.30 crores for the construction of 218 km roads in Pathanamthitta, Idukki and Wayanad districts, in DBMT mode with Project Management Unit, RKI, LSGD (PMU) as implementing agency. Later, vide Government Order read as 4th paper above, it was decided that the 218 km of roads shall be executed in Item Rate mode of contract with long term maintenance element instead of DBMT mode.

Vide Order read as 1st paper KIIFB had been directed to provide necessary support to the PMU and based on this KIIFB prepared DPRs for 3 districts viz., Pathanamthitta, Idukki and Wayanad. KIIFB, while preparing the DPR, conducted CBR investigations only for Pathanamthitta district. The Project Management Unit therefore entrusted the work of “CBR investigation of road works in Wayanad district” to M/s Esteem Developers which was involved in the same works in Pathanamthitta district by KIIFB. The rate quoted by M/s Esteem Developers was Rs.6710+GST. Further, with the concurrence of Planning and Economic Affairs (RKI) Department, the Project Management Unit entered into an agreement with the firm for conducting CBR

investigations for 64.81km of roads at the rate of 1 sample per kilometer with probable expense of Rs.5,46,328/-. M/s Esteem Developers furnished the CBR results and the same was concurred by the Technical Committee of PMU on 18/02/2020.

Project Director, vide letter read as 5th paper above requested for according Administrative Sanction for 'CBR works of roads in Wayanad district' for an amount of Rs.5.5lakhs. Further, Planning and Economic Affairs (RKI) Department has informed that the expenditure of Rs.5,46,328/- towards the work 'CBR investigation for roads in Wayanad district can be met from the funds of Rs.15 crore already allotted to PMU-LSGD as per GO read as 6th paper above.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the work 'CBR investigation of roads in Wayanad district' at a cost of Rs.5,46,328/-, meeting the expenditure from Rs.15 crore already allotted to PMU-LSGD from the budget provision of Rs.250 crore allocated under the head of account '5475-00-115-94-post flood projects under the Rebuild Kerala Initiative-(01)-Roads of Local Self Government (RKI) (Plan) as per GO read as 6th paper above.


