CIRCULAR

Sub:- Government directions to Public Sector Undertakings-
Bureau of Public Enterprises guidelines- Observance of.

Bureau of public Enterprises is formed for and is entrusted with the work of processing important proposals from Public Enterprises and suggesting ways and means for improving, strengthening or streamlining their working in general. The new Industrial Policy also envisages a crucial role for Bureau of Public Enterprises.

2. One of the specific functions of the Bureau of Public Enterprises is the introduction of uniform procedures that would lead to more effective functioning of Public Sector Undertakings under the Administrative Control of different departments in Government Secretariat. In discharging this function, Bureau of Public Enterprises issues guidelines or circulars covering all Public Sector Undertakings. If certain Public Sector Undertakings are exempted from the purview of such guidelines or circulars without examining the merits of each individual case, it would nullify all efforts to streamline the systems followed in various Public Sector Undertakings. In this context, Chief Minister has ordered as follow:

“Guidelines issued by Bureau of Public Enterprises should be observed by all Public Sector Undertaking”.

3. The orders of Chief Minister are brought to the notice of all Administrative Departments and Public Sector Undertakings for strict compliance.

4. Any deviation from guidelines or instructions issued shall be made only with the prior concurrence of Bureau of Public Enterprises.
