Sub :- LSGD - Reuse of recycled water - Instruction issued - reg.


The increasing population growth and changes in life style of the people have increased the demand for water and the water supply sources are overstretched. It leads to the steady decrease in the per capita availability of water in the existing water supply system. This necessitates the recycling of grey water and reuse it for flushing of toilets, gardening and construction purposes.

In the circumstances, Government consider it necessary to make mandatory provision for reuse of recycled water in the Municipal Building Rules. Before that all the Municipalities and Municipal Corporations shall conduct awareness programmes for the public through electronic/print media, seminars, workshops, exhibitions etc regarding the use of waste water generated from bathroom, laundry and kitchen (grey water) for gardening, flushing of toilets, construction activities etc.
