A meeting held on 17.1.2001 by the Minister (Local Self Government Department) with the Chairman and Officers of all Development Authorities except the Goshree Islands Development Authority has reviewed the functioning of the Authorities in the State. It has been revealed in the meeting that establishment costs of the Authorities are exorbitant and most of the authorities find it difficult to pay salary to the staff due to paucity of funds. Besides due to delegation of Authority to the Local Government institutions by virtue of Kerala Panchayath Raj Act 1999 Kerala Municipalities Act 1999 and on account of peoples planning the volume of works in the Development Authorities have diminished. So has been decided to abolish all vacant posts in the Development Authorities except those in the Goshree Island Development Authority.

In the circumstance Government are pleased to order all the vacant posts in the Thiruvananthapuram Development Authority, Greater Cochin Development Authority, Thiruvananthapuram Development Authority and Calicut Development Authority detailed in the annexure to this Government order abolished with immediate effect.
