And in pursuance of the Government Orders read as 1st and 2nd papers above, Government hereby accord sanction for the release of **Rs.40,00,000 (Rupees Forty Lakhs only)** to Aluva Municipality for constructing a temporary foot bridge across the periyar river in connection with the forthcoming Sivarathri Festival. and also to transfer credit the amount to the Public Account as detailed below.
