ORDER

As per the existing guidelines funds are not earmarked separately for the maintenance of roads constructed under PMGSY belonging to the District Panchayats. Government as per the GO read as 1st paper above have ordered that expenditure for the maintenance of roads constructed and transferred to District Panchayats under PMGSY project, for 5 years shall be borne from the maintenance fund of the District Panchayat concerned. By that the practice was that the Commissioner for Rural Development would intimate to Local Self Government Department, the details of funds to be set apart for the purpose during March of every year and the Secretary, Local Self Government Department would deduct the amount from the maintenance fund of the respective District Panchayats from the fund earmarked to them in the appropriate instalment of release. This was done in the last financial year as per the G.O. read as 4th paper above.

2. During this financial year, the Member Secretary, KSRRDA in his letter read as 5th paper above requested the Government that an amount of Rs. 468.594 lakhs is required for the maintenance of PMGSY roads for the current financial year and has requested to release an amount of Rs. 234.297 lakhs as 1st instalment of maintenance fund for PMGSY road works completed up to 31.03.2011 and this has been reported by the Commissioner for Rural Development in his letter read as sixth paper above.

Government have accorded sanction for the release of an amount of Rs.234.297 lakhs (Two hundred and thirty four lakhs twenty nine thousand and seven hundred only) subject to the condition that the amount is to be met from the maintenance of Road Fund of the Panchayats vide G.O. read as 2nd paper above.

3. Owing to the non specific direction in the G.O. read as 2nd paper above. Local Self Government (FM) Department could not deduct even from the 10th and the last instalment of the Maintenance Fund (Road Assets) released to the District Panchayat vide G.O. read as fourth above.


4. Government after having examined the matter in detail have decided to recover the required amount of **Rs.234.297 lakhs (Two hundred and thirty four lakhs twenty nine thousand and seven hundred only)** from the funds for the maintenance fund (Road Assets) already released to the District Panchayats concerned as detailed in annexure and accord sanction to the concerned Secretary to the District Panchayat to draw the amount specified against the name of the District Panchayat from Maintenance fund for road assets and remit the same through RTGS /NEFT transfer to the account (No.10347397292) of the KSRRDA with the State Bank of India Nanthancode Branch (Branch Code: 7898, IFSC code : SBIN0007898, Phone No. (0471) 2311444. 2315384) Thiruvananthapuram or by crossed Demand Draft.
