ORDER

1. As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have issued revised guidelines for the allocation and withdrawal of funds to Local Self Government Institutions.

2. As per the Government Order read as 5th, 8th and 11th paper above, sanction was accorded for the release of 1st, 2nd and 3rd installments of funds for Maintenance Expenditure for the month of April, May and June 2012.

3. As per the Government Order read as 12th paper above, an amount of **Rs.103,85,71,900/- (Rupees One hundred and three crore eighty five lakh seventy one thousand nine hundred only)** was transfer credited from the Consolidated Fund under Major Head of Account, '3054 -Roads and Bridges' and '3604 - Compensation and Assignments to Local Bodies and Panchayat Raj Institutions' to the Public Account under Major Head of Account, '8448 - Deposits of Local Funds' as 4th installment for July 2012 and also sanctioned

its release towards the Funds for Maintenance Expenditure (Road Assets & Non-Road Assets). Accordingly sanction is accorded for the release of **Rs.33,14,43,900/- (Rupees Thirty Three Crore Fourteen lakh Forty Three thousand Nine hundred only)** for maintenance expenditure of Non-Road Assets and **Rs. 70,71,28,000/- (Rupees Seventy Crore Seventy One lakh Twenty Eight thousand only)** for maintenance expenditure of Road Assets from the funds so transfer credited being $\frac{1}{10}$ th of allocation earmarked to the Local Self Government Institutions as 4th installment for the month of July 2012.

4. The distribution of funds among the Local Self Government Institutions is based on the statement appended to the Government Order read as 12th paper above. The amount so transfer credited is exempted from treasury restrictions.

5. The progressive amount of release of funds to the Local Self Government Institutions for Maintenance Expenditure (Road Assets and Non-Road Assets) during 2012-13 including the release as per this Government Order is Rs.415,42,87,600/-

6. The Controlling Officers concerned will issue necessary orders indicating the institution - wise release of the fund (net amount) and Letter of Authority (in form Annexure C - 1) to the respective Local Governments and to the Treasuries concerned for the release of installment for July, 2012 based on the sector-wise distribution shown in Appendix IV to the detailed Budget Estimates 2012-13. In the case of Grama Panchayats, Deputy Director of Panchayats of the respective District will sign the Letter of Authority to the Grama Panchayats under their jurisdiction on the strength of the proceedings releasing the funds (indicating the amount released to each Grama Panchayat with District - wise total) to be issued by the Director of Panchayats.

7. As per the existing guidelines the expenditure for the maintenance of roads constructed and transferred to District Panchayats under PMGSY for 5 years shall be met from the Maintenance Fund (Road Assets) of District Panchayats concerned. Accordingly, vide G.O. read as 13th paper above, it is to deduct the second installment of maintenance fund for PMGSY road works completed up to 31.03.2011, for the year 2011-12 from this and forthcoming releases under Funds for Maintenance Expenditure (Road Assets) allotted to District Panchayats for the maintenance of roads. The Commissioner for Rural Development is authorized to draw the amount shown in the seventh column of 8(i) paragraph below as deducted from the maintenance Fund for Road asset to District Panchayat and remit it to KSRRDA.

8. Accordingly Government are pleased to release the 4th installment of Maintenance expenditure to District Panchayats and Corporations as follows;

9. The Director of Panchayats (in the case of Grama Panchayats) and Director of Urban Affairs (in the case of Municipalities) are directed to adhere the instructions numbered as 2 & 3 in the Government Order read as 10th above.

10. The Director of Urban Affairs is also authorised to draw the amount deducted towards water charge arrear as detailed in para 8 (ii) 6th column and to remit the same to Kerala Water Authority under intimation to Government.

11. The letter of authority to each Local Self Government Institution (District Panchayats and Corporations) and the District Treasury Officer concerned is appended to this order.

12. All the LSGIs are to adhere to the instructions contained in paragraph 17 of the G.O. read as first paper and paragraph 2.2.2 of the circular read as second paper and the controlling officers should inform the LSGIs that the General Purpose Fund, Development Fund and Maintenance Fund will not be released to those LSGIs failing to comply with those orders.

13. The Director of Panchayats, the Director of Urban Affairs and Commissioner for Rural Development are directed *to withheld the release of (4th installment - July 2012 onwards) funds for the maintenance expenses to those Local Self Government Institutions, till the receipt of the information that those LSGI had furnished the E-copy of their Assets Register to the Information Kerala Mission, as per the Circular read as seventh paper above.*


