Sub:- Kerala Service Rules - Rule 140 (c) Part I - Instructions issued - Reg.

Ref:- GO(P) 45/13/Fin dated 22.01.2013.

As per Rule 140 (c) Part I Kerala Service Rules incorporated by GO(P) 45/13/Fin dated 22.01.2013, the period of deputation to foreign service will be initially for one year and may be extended year by year up to a continuous period of five years in the aggregate. The officer on foreign service will be relieved of his duties on the date of expiry of the sanctioned period unless the competent authority has, with requisite approval, extended the period of deputation, in writing, prior to the date of its expiry. In the event of the officer overstaying he will be liable to disciplinary action and the period of overstay will not be counted for the purpose of pension and that any increment due during the period of overstay will be deferred with cumulative effect, till the date on which the officer rejoins his parent cadre. No ex-post facto approval for regularization of overstay on foreign service will be allowed. The officer will be precluded from drawing pay and allowances from the date on which the sanctioned term of foreign service expires. The period of leave, if any, taken by an officer, as per rules applicable to him, on the conclusion of foreign service and before joining his post will not be considered as an overstay under this sub-rule. The provisions of this sub-rule have been made applicable to an officer on deputation from one service to another or from one Department to another within the same service.

Since sub-rule 140(c) Part I, Kerala Service Rules takes effect from 22.01.2013, all deputations including extension sanctioned from that date will be subject to the terms and conditions specified therein. Hence all Competent Authorities sanctioning deputation including extension of deputation are directed to specify the conditions mentioned above in the orders sanctioning deputation, without fail.
