ORDER

As per Order read as first paper above Kerala Administrative Tribunal directed the first respondent (Government), in OA No. EKM 66/13 filed by Sri. V Doraswami, LDC (formerly), Nallepilly Grama Panchayat, Palakkad to consider and dispose of Annexure A6 representation preferred by the applicant in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of being heard to him within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of the Order. Annexure A6 is the representation of the applicant to the Government for granting pensionery benefits or compassionate allowances as per Rule 5, Part III KSRs. Accordingly Director of Panchayats submitted report as per letter read as 2nd above.

The applicant was heard on 12.09.2013 by the Deputy Secretary to Government. Sri. V Doraswami while working as LDC in the Nallepilly Grama Panchayat was charge sheeted in a cheating case as CC No. 161/02 before the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court, Chittur u/s 417 IPC. The Hon'ble court by judgment dated 21.10.2004 convicted Sri Doraswami and sentenced him to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of four months. He suffered four months imprisonment and the period was considered as absence from duty. Subsequently the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Palakkad removed him from service as per Order No. AVS/6963/06 dated 15.10.2007. As such he is not entitled for pensionery benefits from the Government.

The applicant submitted that he was removed from service at the fag end of his service and taking into consideration of his poor financial position he has requested to grant him compassionate allowances. Rule 5, Part III, KSRs provide for the grant of compassionate allowances to an officer dismissed or removed from service for misconduct, insolvency or inefficiency when the case deserves special consideration.

Government have examined the matter in detail. In the circumstances and as reported by the Director of Panchayats as per letter read as 2nd above, Government are pleased to accord sanction for granting compassionate allowances to Sri. V Doraswami, LDC (formerly), Nallepilly Grama Panchayat, Palakkad as per Rule 5, Part III, KSRs.


Orders of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 1st paper above is complied with accordingly.
