ORDER

In the order read as 2nd paper above, the Hon'ble Administrative Tribunal directed the Government to consider and dispose the Annexure A5 representation in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of being heard to the applicant within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

Shri. K. Rashmidharan, Retired Superintendent, Kollam Corporation in his representation read as 1st paper above and referred as Annexure A5 in the OA 886/14 has requested Government to take appropriate action enabling the release of the amount of Rs.2,75,524/- (Rupees two lakhs seventy five thousand five hundred and twenty four only) to him being the balance of Death Cum Retirement Gratuity.

Government representative heard the petitioner on 16.07.2014 and examined the matter with respect to the reports of the Director of Urban

Affairs and Secretary, Kollam Corporation. Secretary, Kollam Corporation in his letter read as 4th paper above has reported that no reply from Local Fund Audit Department is received regarding the dropping of the audit objections or acceptance of the ATR furnished by the Corporation on the objection raised by Director, Local Fund Audit. It is also seen that an amount of Rs. 2,75,524/- has been withheld on account of audit objection raised by Director of Local Fund Audit, the same cannot be released after obtaining an undertaking from the incumbent.

In the above circumstances, Annexure A5 representation is disposed of with a direction to the Director of Urban Affairs to take immediate action to clear the audit objection and if any amount is fixed as liability against the incumbent that amount has to be recovered from his DCRG and to release balance amount due to the petitioner accordingly.

Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as IInd paper above is thus complied with.
