ORDER

Based on the enquiry report of the State Performance Audit Wing on the allegation of misuse of maintenance grant of Alappuzha Municipality for the year 2004-05, Shri. B. Indrabalan Pillai, former Secretary and Shri.A.K. Vikraman, Asst. Engineer were suspended from service as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above. Later, Shri.A.K. Vikraman was reinstated in to service pending enquiry and disciplinary action as per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above. Vigilance Department has also conducted a Vigilance enquiry in the above allegation and decided to register two Vigilance cases. The Vigilance Department has insisted not to take department disciplinary action against the accused and requested to wait for the completion of the investigation/ enquiry by the Director, Vigilance & Anti Corruption Bureau. Final enquiry report of the Director, Vigilance & Anti Corruption Bureau is not seen received yet.

In the mean time Smt. Meera Vikraman, W/o of K.R. Vikraman (Assistant Engineer) who died on 18.10.2009, has filed OA 1372/2013 praying to direct the respondents to sanction family pension due to the petitioner. Hon' ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal in the interim order read as 3rd above has directed the 2nd respondent [the Director of Urban Affairs]

to regularize the period of suspension of the applicant's husband for the aforementioned period within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

The Director of Urban Affairs vide reference 4th above has informed that pension application of the incumbent is pending for want of Government Order regularizing the suspension period from 30.08.2005 to 24.11.2005 that he was under suspension as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

Government have examined the matter in detail. Shri. K.R. Vikraman was expired on 13.10.2009 while working in Thrissur Corporation. Hence no further action is possible against him. In the light of the Interim Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal and also taking a lenient view, the suspension period in respect of Shri. K.R. Vikraman, Asst. Engineer from 30.08.2005 to 24.11.2005 is hereby regularized as duty for all purpose limiting pay and allowances as subsistence allowance that he has already drawn.

The Interim Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 3rd above is complied with accordingly.


