ORDER

As per GO read as 1st paper above Government have issued orders for creating the posts of Drivers in various Grama Panchayats in the districts of Thiruvananthapuram, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Idukki, Malappuram and Kozhikkode and directed the Director of Panchayats to report the vacancies to Kerala Public Service Commission for filling these newly created vacancies urgently. Based on the above order, Director of Panchayats initiated action to fill up the vacancies of drivers through KPSC. Subsequently Sri.Shaji.K.R and 5 others who were working as drivers in the various Grama Panchayats in Idukki districts on daily wages filed WP© No. 11367 /2014 (u) before the Hon'ble High Court with a prayer to regularize their service as drivers in their respective Panchayats by cancelling the GO read as 1st paper above.

The Hon'ble High Court in its judgment dated 25.04.2014 in WP© 11367/2014 directed Government to consider Ext.P3 series of representations with notice to the petitioners with in a period of two months from the date of production of copy of the judgment. The Ext. P3 representations are the requests of the petitioners before the Govt for regularization of their service as drivers in various Panchayats since they worked there for long as drivers and to cancel the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

In the light of the judgment, the petitioners were heard by the Deputy Secretary , LSGD. In the hearing, they have requested for regularization of their service as drivers in their respective Panchayats since they have worked for more than 8 years.

Government have examined the case in detail. The requests for regularization of the service of the petitioners cannot be considered since PSC hands have already joined in their posts. In the above circumstances the prayer of the petitioners for regularization in service as Drivers cannot be considered and hence hereby declined.

The Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 11367/14(u) dated 25/04/2014 is complied with accordingly.
