ORDER

As proposed by **Sri. K.Raju, MLA representing Punalur Constituency** under LAC-ADS for the year 2015-16 as per the reference read as 2nd paper above, the Assistant Engineer, PWD Road Section, Punalur has furnished detailed estimate of the work '**Construction of Murukan Kovil-Pulimukku Road from Ch 0/000 to 0/650 Km in ward No.4 of Thenmala Grama Panchayat**' at an estimate cost of **Rs.33,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Three Lac only)** as per the reference read as 3rd paper above to accord Administrative Sanction and Special Sanction. Thenmala Grama Panchayat passed and forwarded resolution in this regard as per the reference read as 4th paper above.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the work '**Construction of Murukan Kovil-Pulimukku Road from Ch 0/000 to 0/650 Km in ward No.4 of Thenmala Grama Panchayat**' proposed under LAC-ADS of **Sri.
