**ORDER**

As per the Government of India letters read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above have directed State Government to issue necessary Government orders for the implementation of PFMS to the Indira Awaas Yojana beneficiaries and also suggested constitution of an Advisory Committee for implementation of PFMS under IAY. The Commissioner for Rural Development as per the letters read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above has furnished necessary proposals for implementation of the above directions. Hence vide Government letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above in principle sanction has been issued for the implementation of Public Financial Management System (PFMS). As the next step an advisory committee has to be constituted and necessary direction has to be given to Commissioner for Rural Development for opening a separate account in a Nationalised Bank.

5) The Advisory Committee shall periodically convene & review the progress of the pilot implementation of PFMS and suggest correction measures if needed. The Advisory Committee shall meet at least once in every six months. Sanction is also accorded to the Commissioner for Rural Development for maintaining a separate account for IAY in a nationalised Bank and to park the money transferred from treasury account in nationalised bank only. The balance amount in the bank account at the end of each day shall not exceed Rs.5 Crores.
