ORDER

The Hon'ble High Court in its Judgment read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above has directed the Government (1st respondent) to consider Exhibit P8 representation with notice to the petitioner and respondents 2 to 4 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of the judgment. Exhibit P8 is the representation submitted by the petitioner to accord building permit to the gas godown.

2. The petitioner was heard in accordance with the direction of the Hon'ble High Court on 7.10.15 with the presence of the representatives of respondents No 2- 4. During the time of hearing the petitioner had submitted that she had submitted an application for permission to construct LPG gas godown before the Puthenvelikkara Grama Panchayath and the Grama Panchayath rejected the application on the ground that the road access to the godown has no mandatory width of 7 m and the wicket gate to the building has only 1.2 m width. The petitioner contented that the road access to the plot has 3.5 m width and the width of the wicket gate (1.2m) is as per the norms of the Bureau and Explosives Safety Organization. Also the petitioner has informed that she is ready to build the godown as per the rules and regulations of the concerned authorities and shall submit the plan to the local body accordingly.

3) The representative of the Chief Town Planner has reported that it is mandatory that the road to the godown should have 7m width. The representative of the Bharath Petroleum Corporation Limited has informed that the rocket gate should have only 1.2 m width as per the condition of Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organization. The condition is that 'a shed used for storage of liquefied petroleum gas cylinders shall be surrounded by a suitable and brick masonry compound wall of 1.8m height with a 1.2m width gate to prevent unauthorised person from having access to the shed and its safety zone'. It is according to this condition the above construction got NOC from Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organization.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to direct the Secretary, Puthenvelikkara Grama Panchayath to consider the application for the construction of LPG Godown as per the rules of Kerala Panchayath Buiding Rules when the petitioner submits the plan for construction.


5) The directions contained in the Judgment read above are thus complied with.
