ORDER

By disposing OA(EKM)-28/2015 filed by Sri. Issac Varghis the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal directed the first respondent ie. the principal Secretary,LSGD Government (1st Respondent) to take a decision on the grievances of the Applicant voiced in Annexure A8 and also in Annexure A4 & A6, in accordance with law within 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of the Order after affording an opportunity of being heard in person.

Annexure A4 & A6 are the representations submitted before the Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam for regularisation of his leave period and also for granting pensionary benefits and pay revision arrears etc. Pursuant to the Hon'ble Tribunal's direction, the Applicant was heard on 07.07.2015.

Disciplinary action was initiated against the applicant while he was working in Rayamangalam Gramapanchayat for unauthorised absence and finalised. Eventhough the Applicant submitted Leave Application for regularising the period of absence from 01.11.2008 to 27.03.2011, on Medical Certificate, he had submitted

Medical Certificate from 01.10.2010 onwards. The Same was returned and the Applicant resubmitted the leave application only on 12.02.2015. The Deputy Director of Panchayats, Ernakulam has reported that the pensionary benefits and pay revision arrears could be calculated only after finalising the regularisation of the Applicant's period of absence from duty.

The Director of Panchayats has furnished proposal for leave regularisation of absence of the Applicant and is under active consideration of Government. Once the Leave period is regularised the applicant's pensionary benefits and pay revision arrears will be disbursed by the concerned.

Orders of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read above is complied with accordingly.
