ORDER

As per the G.O. read as paper 1st above, Government have accorded sanction to the CE, LSGD to grant temporary promotion to eligible candidates up to the cadre of Junior Superintendent under Rule 31(a)(i) Part II KS & SSRs subject to certain conditions. Pursuant to this order, the Chief Engineer, LSGD as per the proceedings dated 12/02/2014 read as 2nd paper above temporarily promoted 22 L.D. Typists as U.D. Typists.

2. As per the letter read as 4th paper above, the Chief Engineer has submitted proposal for the regularisation of the temporary promotions effected. The Chief Engineer has reported that 105 posts of Typists from PWD and 43 posts of Typists from Water Resources Department were accommodated in the LSGD Engineering Wing. Hence as on 25/8/2008 there were 148 posts of Typists in the ratio of 1:1 between L.D. Typists (74) and U.D. Typists (74) in the LSGD Engineering Wing. Therefore the CE recommends that the temporary promotion of the aforesaid L.D. Typists as U.D. Typists may be regularized on the date of their successful completion of the period of probation. The Chief Engineer further reported that as per the G.O. read as paper 3rd above Smt. Sindhu S. and Smt. Kavitha K.G.(Sl. No. 8 & 9 respectively in the Seniority list) were regularized as U.D. Typists and hence requested that the temporary promotion of the remaining 20 incumbents may be regularized.

3. Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to the Chief Engineer, LSGD to regularize the

temporary promotions of the aforesaid 20 L.D. Typists to the cadre of U.D. Typists on the date of successful completion of the period of probation of each incumbent.


