ORDER

As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, four Assistant Engineers namely, Smt. Fabeena H., Sri. Anoj Kumar P.R., Smt. Josna V.S. and Sri. Rajeev K.S. from the LSGD Engineering Wing were selected for the M Tech Course in Translational Engineering at the Government Engineering College, Barton Hill, Thiruvananthapuram as Government sponsored candidates. As per the Proceedings read as paper 3rd above, the Chief Engineer, LSGD relieved the incumbents to join the Course and as per the letters read as paper 4th above, Chief Engineer, LSGD has requested to grant deputation benefits to the Assistant Engineers relieved.

2. As per the G.O. Read as paper 5th above, additional expenditure to the tune of ₹6,00,000/- (Six lakhs rupees only) in the Head of Account "2515 Other Rural Development Programmes- 001 Direction and Administration-91 Engineering Wing for Local Self Government Institutions- Supervision- 34 Other Charges-3 Other items" was authorized to meet the Course fee. As per Letter referred as 2nd paper above Higher Education Department has informed that deputation benefits can be granted to

the faculties undergoing M Tech study under the sponsored scheme subject to the conditions stipulated in GO(P) No. 303/1970/Fin dtd 12/05/1970.

3. In the above circumstance, sanction is accorded for granting deputation benefits to the Assistant Engineers relieved for attending the M. Tech course in Translational Engineering at the Government Engineering College, Barton Hill, Thiruvananthapuram, subject to the conditions stipulated in G.O(P) No. 303/1970/Fin dtd 12/05/1970. The Chief Engineer, LSGD should make sure that in order to grant deputation benefits one post in the equivalent cadre is kept vacant during the deputation period.
