ORDER

The Surprise Check conducted by the Kollam Unit of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau in the Engineering Wing of Kollam Corporation Office on 10/6/2011 revealed that personal cash declaration register, Ministerial Casual Leave Register, casual leave register for executive officers, tender sales register and deposit register are not properly maintained in that office.

2. Based Surprise check report the Director of Vigilance & Anti- corruption Bureau as per the letter read as 1st paper above, recommended departmental action against Sri. L Gopakumar, Junior Superintendent, Engineering Wing of Kollam Corporation Office for the above irregularity.

3. Government have examined the recommendation of the Director of Vigilance & Anti- corruption Bureau and accepted the same. Accordingly Sri. Gopakumar, Junior Superintendent was issued memo of charges read as 2nd paper above for minor penalty for non-maintenance of Personal Cash Declaration Register, Personal Register, and Casual Leave Register of Ministerial

and Executive Staff. In the written statement of defence, read as 3rd paper above, Sri.L. Gopakumar submitted that during that time he was in charge of 11 Section Clerks and the non-maintenance of registers were not intentional. He submitted that his work load was so heavy and requested Government to exonerate him from the charges levelled against him.

4. The Director of Urban Affairs in his letter read as 4th paper above has reported that Sri. L.Gopakumar retired from service on 31.05.2015 and has recommended to exempt him from further disciplinary proceedings considering that the lapse on his part to maintain all the registers in the office is non intentional and also considering that he retired from service.

5. Government examined the case in detail with the report of the Director of Vigilance & Anti- corruption Bureau and the Director of Urban Affairs. Since the charges levelled against Sri.L. Gopakumar, former Junior Superintendent, Engineering Wing of Kollam Corporation Office is not so grave and also considering the fact that he retired from service, the disciplinary action initiated against him is hereby dropped and ordered accordingly.
