### ORDER

Sri. A.Shamnad entered in service as Village Extension Officer in Alappuzha district on 19/03/2003. While working as Village Extension Officer in Muthukulam Block in Alappuzha district, a Vigilance case (VC 10/2011/ALP) was registered against him in connection with the allotment of funds to Arattupuzha Grama Panchayath. Subsequently, he was suspended from service as per the Government Order cited 1<sup>st</sup> above. Later, he was reinstated in service as per the Government Order cited 2<sup>nd</sup> above. He was posted at Markada Block Panchayath, and thereafter transferred to Vengara Block Panchayath, Malappuram district by the Commissioner for Rural Development.

He submitted several representations before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent (Commissioner for Rural Development) for a convenient transfer to his home district or neighbouring districts. But the same has declined owing to the pendency of the said Vigilance case.

The applicant submitted a representation (Annexure-A5) before the Government requesting to transfer him back to Alappuzha District. Also, he filed OA No. 27/2017 before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal praying for a direction to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent of pass appropriate orders on Annexure-A5.

As per the order read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal has directed the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to consider the request of the applicant for a posting in

Alappuzha district or in any other neighbouring districts after affording an opportunity of being heard to the applicant within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

As per the direction of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, the applicant was heard by the Deputy Secretary on 10/03/2017.

The investigation of the said case is over and charge sheet has been filed before the court. In this circumstances, Government are pleased to dispose this case with a direction to the Commissioner for Rural Development to give transfer to the applicant to the neighbouring districts of Alappuzha district, forth with.

The direction of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal is thus complied with.


