ORDER

As per Order read as 1st paper above, the Director of Urban Affairs issued transfer and postings in the cadre of Senior Clerks of Municipal Common Service. In that Order Shri.Aneesh K.C., Senior Clerk has been transferred to Kozhikode Municipality on administrative convenience. Against this order, Shri. Aneesh K.C. filed appeal petition read as 2nd paper above before the Government. In the appeal petition he submitted that while he was transferred out, persons having more years of service are retained in Kochi Corporation. He had not submitted any transfer request. Also he is living in Cheranallur at Ernakulam with his wife and three small children. He therefore, requested to retain him in Kochi Corporation.

2. In connection with the above transfer, Shri. Aneesh K.C. filed OA (EKM) 1167/16 before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal. The Hon'ble Tribunal in the Order read as 3rd paper above directed the 1st Respondent, Secretary to Government, LSGD to consider and pass orders on Annexure A2 appeal within two

months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order, after affording an opportunity of being heard to the applicant.

3. In accordance with the direction of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, Shri. Aneesh K.C was heard by the Under Secretary to Government, Local Self Government Department on 05.04.2017. During the hearing the applicant reiterated his earlier submission that he is suffering from Fits and that he is under medical advice to not to stay away from home. In the Transfer Order he has been posted at Kozhikode and hence requested again that he may be posted within Kochi itself on humanitarian grounds.

4. Government have examined the Annexure A2 Appeal Petition read as 2nd paper above in detail with the report of the Director of Urban Affairs read as 4th paper above along with the transfer norms of Local Self Government Department. The Director of Urban Affairs reported that the transfer of Shri. Aneesh.K.C to Ernakulam can be considered during the General Transfer 2017-18 subject to his eligibility.

5. In the above circumstances, Government dispose Annexure A2 appeal petition of Shri. Aneesh K.C., Senior Clerk with a direction to the Director of Urban affairs, to take a favourable decision regarding his posting in Ernakulam District during the General Transfer, May 2017 considering his physical disability.


