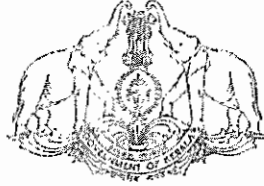

ORDER

Sri. Roy Davis, Head Clerk, Mooliyar Gramapanchayat, Kasaragode filed OA 86/2017 before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal seeking his transfer and posting to a convenient station of his order of preference.

2. By disposing OA 86/2017, the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal directed the 1st respondent, i.e the Government to take decision on Annexure A4 representation after hearing the applicant within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

3. The applicant in this case Sri. Roy Davis who has been working as Accountant in the Arimpur Gramapanchayat in Thrissur was posted to Mooliyar Gramapanchayat, Kasaragode during conversion or posting of Head Clerks vide order read as 4th paper above.

4. In pursuance to the direction of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, the applicant was heard to person by the Under Secretary to Government on 17.03.2017. During the course of hearing, the Applicant deposed that many of his juniors had been given postings in their respective Districts and some of them

were given posting in the very same office while passing the above said transfer order of the Director of Panchayats. The seniority is not at all considered and he was denied posting in Thrissur or neighbouring districts; but posted in the far away Kasaragod District which is an inconvenient place for him considering his bad health and family conditions.

5. The Director of Panchayats informed that during promotion / conversion, the employees are given posting in their own District, if there exist open vacancy. In the case of the applicant, as there was no suitable place to accommodate him in Thrissur District, he was given posting in the Kasaragode district. In the Panchayat Department, transfer and postings of the employees including the Supervisory Officers are not entertained during the fag end of the Financial Year.

6. Government have examined the matter in detail and pleased to order that the Director of Panchayats will post Sri. Roy Davis, Head Clerk, Mooliyar Gramapanchayat, Kasargode district in a suitable place in Thrissur district during the General Transfer, 2017, if he is otherwise eligible.

7. The order of Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 1st paper above is complied with as above.
