ORDER

WHEREAS it has been disclosed from the records of investigation in VC.5/2009/ALP of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau Police Station, Alappuzha that Sri.Sisupalan, S/o George, Block Development Officer, Block Panchayat, Bharanikkavu during the year 2007-2008 and as such being public servant and the implementing officer of the renovation work of the Maneenath Temple road in Nooranadu Panchayat abused his official position and entered into criminal conspiracy with Sri.P.R.Suresh, S/o Ramankutty, Block Panchayat Member, Bharanikkavu Block Panchayat, Sri.P.K.Rajendran, S/o Kunjilan, Assistant Engineer, Bharanikkavu Block Panchayat, Sri.Shylajan Nair, S/o Krishnankutty Nair, Village Extension Officer, Padanilam (VEO Circle), Grama Panchayat, Nooranad, Sri.Pushparajan, S/o Thankappan, Sri.P.Prabhakara Kurup, S/o Parameswaran Pillai, Assistant Executive Engineer, Poverty Alleviation Unit, District Panchayat, Alappuzha and Sri.R.Gangadharan, S/o Kunjiraman, Chairman, Standing Committee on Development Block Panchayat,

Bharanikkavu and in furtherance of it, the said Sri.Sisupalan fraudulently and dishonestly effected excess payment to the convener without verifying whether the work was carried out or not and caused loss of Rs.1,63,040/- to the Government Exchequer. Further forged the documents were created and used as genuine in connection with the renovation work of the Maneenath Temple Road in Norranadu Panchayat and obtained undue pecuniary advantage for himself and also for other accused who were connived with Sri.Sisupalan. Thereby committed criminal misconduct and offences under P.C.Act, 1988 and IPC.

AND WHEREAS the said acts constitute offences punishable U/s.13(2) r/w.13(1) (c) & (d) of the P.C.Act, 1988 and Sec.409,465,468,471 and 120-B IPC.

AND WHEREAS Government of Kerala after fully and carefully examining the records and circumstances of the case consider that the said Sri.Sisupalan should be prosecuted before a Court of law;

NOW THEREFORE Government of Kerala do hereby accord sanction under Clause (b) of Sub Section (1) of Section 19 of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 for the prosecution of the said Sri.Sisupalan.G for the said offences and any other offences punishable under any other provisions of law in respect of the acts above said and for taking cognizance of the said offences by a court of competent jurisdiction.


