**ORDER**

Shri. G. Sabu, Health Inspector Grade I joined Municipal Common Service on 11.02.2003 as Junior Health Inspector Grade II without service break after rendering his service as Forest Guard in Forest Department from 01.03.2001. He submitted an application to the Director of Urban Affairs on 15.11.2010, through the Corporation Secretary for protecting his pay in the Forest Department. Accordingly, the Director of Urban Affairs sought clarification from Government in this regard and it was clarified that since Shri. Sabu came to Municipal Common Service from a lower pay, his pay need not be protected and that his service in Forest Department can be counted for his pensionary benefits.

2. Against the above decision Shri.G. Sabu filed representation read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above before Government with a request to protect his pay in the Forest Department. He also filed OA 462/17 before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal with the same prayer. The Hon'ble Tribunal in the Order read as 14.03.2017 directed the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, Government to consider and pass orders on Annexure A6 in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of being heard

to the applicant within three months from the date of receipt of a Certified copy of the order.

3. Accordingly , the Under Secretary, Local Self Government (EU) Department heard the petitioner on 31.05.2017. During the hearing, he submitted that Government have sanctioned the protection of pay of similar persons came from Lower scale to a Higher Scale. If his pay had been protected, then his Grade fixation in Municipal Common Service would have happened 2 years earlier. Thus he lost the benefit of the pay revision. Hence he requested to count his service in Forest Department for pay fixation in Municipal Common Service.

4. Government have examined the case in detail with respect to the report from the Director of Urban Affairs read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above. It is seen that the request of Shri. G. Sabu for protecting his preservice in Forest Department had already been examined and issued orders by protecting his pay considering his service in Forest Department and pay fixation is allowed accordingly vide Government Order read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above.

5. In the circumstances the Annexure A6 representation has become infructuous and hence the same is disposed.

6. The Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 2nd paper above is complied with accordingly.
