ORDER

As per the judgment read as 2nd paper above Hon'ble High Court directed Government to take expeditious action on the application of Smt. Akhila for the post of Clerk in Municipal Common Service on Compassionate Employment Scheme and issue orders on the same, within a period of two months and the 3rd respondent, Secretary, Kochi Corporation, shall there upon take necessary action within a period of two weeks.

2. The Director of Urban Affairs had forwarded the application of Smt. Akhila for the post of Clerk in Municipal Common Service on Compassionate Employment Scheme as per the letter read as 3rd paper above with due recommendation. Government have examined the matter in detail. It is seen that Smt. Akhila has passed the Secondary School examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling. A pass certificate on Secondary School Examination issued by the National Open School is given equivalency with that of Kerala Secondary School of Education is based on the conditions stipulated in GO(Rt) No. 1768/2011/G.Edn dated 12/05/2011. The equivalency certificate can be issued only if the course satisfies the subject combination mentioned in GO(Rt) No. 1768/2011/G.Edn dated 12/05/2011. Since the certificate produced by Smt. Akhila does not satisfy the subject combination, the course passed by Smt. Akhila cannot be considered equivalent to SSLC Examination.

3. As per the order read as 1st paper above, a pass in SSLC is the prescribed qualification for the post of Lower Division Clerk. Since the course passed by Smt. Akhila cannot be considered equivalent to SSLC Examination, the application submitted by Smt. Akhila for the post of Lower Division Clerk under Compassionate Employment Scheme lacks merit and hence remitted back to Director of Urban Affairs with direction to call for the documents from the petitioner to prove that she possesses the basic qualification or equivalent qualification prescribed for the post of LDC/BC and to retransmit as a fresh proposal with due recommendation of the application for a suitable post according to the qualification acquired by the petitioner as per the letter read as 4th paper above.

4. Thus the judgment read as 2nd paper above is complied with accordingly.


