ORDER

Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau conducted a vigilance
surprise check at Karunagappally Municipality on 29.08.2014 based on
the allegation of irregularities in issuing building permit and occupancy
certificates which revealed various irregularities in the maintenance of
registers including casual leave register. The Director, Vigilance &
Anti-Corruption Bureau, as per the letter read as 1st paper above, has
recommended departmental action against the responsible officers and
to give strict instructions to the concerned officials. Therefore,
disciplinary action for minor penalty under Rule 16 KCS (CC&A)
Rules 1960 has been initiated against Shri.M.Mohammed Huwaiz, the
then Secretary, Karunagappally Municipality and Memo of Charges
and Statement of Allegations read as 2nd paper above has been served
on him.

2. In the written statement of defence read as 3rd paper above, Shri.M.Mohammed Huwaiz has informed that the preliminary duty to maintain the casual leaver register is that of the section official concerned. There is a Superintendent who has supervisory control over the concerned section and was given delegation under Section 50(2) of the Kerala Municipality Act. It is also reported that the importance of maintenance of registers were emphasised in the meetings. Registers like casual leave register, personal cash declaration register etc are being strictly maintained in accordance with the guidelines. He has also requested to accept the reply and to drop the charges leveled against him.

3. The Director of Urban Affairs, as per the letter read as 4th paper above, has recommended to accept the reply and to drop the disciplinary action initiated against Shri.M.Mohammed Huwaiz, former Secretary, Karunagappally Municipality by imposing a censure.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to finalise the disciplinary action initiated against Shri.M.Mohammed Huwaiz, former Secretary, Karunagappally Municipality by imposing a censure, under Rule 11(1)(i) of KCS&CCA Rules 1960, with a direction to be careful in dealing with such matters in future.
