ORDER

In order to mitigate the issue of waste accumulation in Urban Areas in the State, Government have decided to set up Centralized waste processing (Waste to Energy) plants at identified locations across the State through Public Private Partnership(PPP). Accordingly as per G.O read as 1st paper above, Government have constituted a State Level Advisory Committee (SLAC) chaired by Chief Secretary to co-ordinate the implementation of the investible projects in the Waste Management Sector of the State. Sanction was also accorded as per G.O. read as 2nd paper above, for releasing an amount of Rs. 2 Crore under the H/A 2217-80-800-63 for the activities in connection with the implementation of the Scheme 'Urban Solid Waste Management Initiative' (USWMI) for the Year * 2017-18. But the amount could not be released during the financial Year 2017-18.

2. As per the G.O. read as 3rd paper above, sanction was accorded for setting up 5MW Solid Waste -to-Energy (WtE) plants at 7 identified locations on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis in Public Private Partnership(PPP) mode. Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC) is the nodal agency for co-ordinating the entire activities such as floating of RFP, promotional campaign etc. related to the implementation of the Scheme and they require funds for such activities. The Managing Director, Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation as per letter read as 4th paper above has requested to take necessary action for allocating sufficient fund in the current Year's Budget for the implementation of the Scheme 'Urban Solid Waste Management Initiative' as there is no allocation in the Budget for the current financial year for the purpose.

- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail. As per the G.O read as 5th paper above, additional expenditure to the tune of Rs. 2 Crore has been authorized under the H/A 2217-80-800-63 for 'Urban Solid Waste Management Initiative' (USWMI) for the year 2018-2019. Therefore Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction to K.S.I.D.C. for an amount of Rs.2 Crore for the activities in connection with the implementation of the Scheme 'Urban Solid Waste Management Initiative' (USWMI).
- 4. Sanction is also accorded to release an amount of Rs. 2 Crore additionally authorized under the H/A 2217-80-800-63 for 'Urban Solid Waste Management Initiative' (USWMI) for the year 2018-2019 as per the G.O read as 5th paper above and also to transfer credit the amount to the Spl. TSB account of the Managing Director, KSIDC.
