ORDER

The Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India launched the Scheme viz. Shyama Prasad Mukharji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) on 16th September 2015 (now known as National Rurban Mission) with an objective to transform rural areas into economically, socially and physically sustainable spaces. The aim of National Rurban Mission (NRUM) is to create 300 such Rurban growth clusters over three years, across the country. The clusters identified by the State Government and approved by the Central Government will be provided with Critical Gap Fund of Rs.30 Crore each on 60:40 proportion. As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, administrative sanction has been accorded for the implementation of National Rurban Mission in Phase I Clusters. The projects of Phase I clusters are in the final stage of implementation in the State.

2) As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the Ministry of Rural Development, GoI has intimated the approval the four clusters of Phase II which are identified by the State Government and sanctioned the initial amount of 35 lakhs each for the preparation of ICAP, training and other initial activities.

3) Detailed Project Report of Phase II clusters was prepared by KILA CHRD and approved in the 10th SLEC meeting held on 28/12/2018. An amount of Rs.50 Crore is earmarked under the H/A 2515-00-102-35 (01) and 2515-00-102-35

(02) for providing the Central Share and corresponding State Share of CGF for the implementation of National Rurban Mission (NRuM). As per the letter read as 4th paper above, Commissioner for Rural Development has submitted proposal for issuing administrative sanction for implementation of National Rurban Mission in Phase II clusters in the State during the year 2019-2020.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail. National Rurban Mission (NRuM) is a continuing Centrally Sponsored Scheme. There is no variation from the scheme operational during the financial year 2018-19 in terms of components, scope, unit costs, etc. and does not include fresh post creation and purchase of vehicle.

5) In the above circumstance, Administrative Sanction is accorded for the implementation of National Rurban Mission (NRuM), Phase II in the following 4 Clusters in Kerala, as approved by the Ministry of Rural Development, for a total amount of Rs.494.56 Core including Convergence Fund and CGF. , as detailed below.
