In exercise of the powers conferred by section 254 read with 235 AB of the Kerala Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 (13 of 1994), the Government of Kerala hereby make the



following rules further to amend the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, issued under G.O.(P)No.12/2018/LSGD. dated 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.96/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.408 dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, namely:-

## RULES

1. *Short title and commencement* .— (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) second Amendment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come in to force on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2018.

2. *Amendment of the rules.*-In the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), for the figures “588”, the figures “771” shall be substituted.

## Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G.O.(P) No.12/2018/LSGD. dated 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.96/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.408 dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the time-limit for filing the application for regularisation of unauthorised construction had been 90 days. As per notification issued under G.O. (P)No.48/2018/LSGD. dated 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.423/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.1662 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2018, the said time limit had been extended to 270 days and as per notification issued under G.O. (P)No.88/2018/LSGD. dated 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.866/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.3055 dated 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2018, the said time limit had been further extended to 405 days. As per notification issued under G.O.(P)No.40/2019/LSGD dated 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 and published as S.R.O No.409/2019 in the Kerala Gazette Extra ordinary No.1388 dated 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, the said time limit had been further extended to 588 days. The said time-limit expired on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. Government have, therefore, decided to extend the said time-limit up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020 so as to provide an opportunity to those who could not file application in time.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
