**ORDER**

The Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India launched the Scheme viz. Shyama Prasad Mukharji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2015 (now it is known as National Rurban Mission) with an objective to transform rural areas into economically, socially and physically sustainable spaces. The aim of National Rurban Mission (NRuM) is to create 300 such Rurban growth clusters over three years, across the country. The clusters identified by the State Government and approved by the Central Government will be provided with Critical Gap with Fund of Rs.30 Crore each on 60:40 proportion. As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction had been accorded for the implementation of NRuM Phase I and Phase II Clusters respectively in Kerala. As per the Government Order read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction had been accorded for the implementation of NRuM Phase III Clusters in Kerala except Pinarayi-Vengad Cluster. The projects of Phase I clusters are in the final stage of implementation and that of Phase II clusters and 3 clusters of the Phase III are in Progress.

- 2) As per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, the Ministry of Rural



Development, GoI has sanctioned Rs.5.40 Crores as 1<sup>st</sup> installment of CGF for Pinarayi-Vengad cluster and the same was released by the government along with its proportionate State Share of Rs.3.60 Crore vide Government Order read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above.

3) The Detailed Project Report of the Pinarayi-Vengad cluster, prepared by KILA CHRD were approved in the 13<sup>th</sup> SLEC meeting held on 24.02.2020. As per the letter read as 6<sup>th</sup> paper above, Commissioner for Rural Development has submitted proposal for issuing Administrative Sanction for implementation of NRuM Phase III in the Pinarayi-Vengad Cluster.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail. National Rural Mission (NRuM) is a continuing Centrally Sponsored Scheme and there is no variation from the Scheme operational during the financial year 2020-21 in terms of components, scope, unit costs, etc. and does not include fresh post creation and purchase of vehicle.

5) In the above circumstance, Administrative Sanction is accorded for the implementation of National Rurban Mission (NRuM) in Pinarayi-Vengad Cluster under Phase III as detailed below;
