### **ORDER**

The guidelines regarding the withdrawal of funds from the Consolidated Fund of the State by the Local Governments (LGs) issued vide Government order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above was modified as per Govt order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above for the drawal of XV Finance Commission Grants.

2) Govt of India, vide OM read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, have issued Guidelines for the implementation of XV Finance Commission Health Sector Grants through Local Governments. The State Government has to open Bank accounts for the purpose of monitoring health sector grant transactions to enable the simplification of the processes and to ensure that no duplication happens with any other scheme for the same subject. The State Finance Department should transfer the grant to the Panchayat Raj Department/ Urban Development Department or Nodal Department for Autonomous District Councils within ten working days without any deduction.

3) Government, after having examined the matter in detail, are pleased to modify the method of transfer of Health Sector Grants, under XV Finance

Commission Award in the following manner: Once the grant-in-aid is received from Govt of India, the fund shall be transfer credited from the Consolidated Fund to the Bank account of Finance Department opened for Health Grants to Local Bodies under Finance Commission Award. This fund shall be transferred from the Bank account of Finance Department to the Bank account of Panchayat Department/ Rural Development Department/ Urban Affairs Department maintained for the purpose , as the case may be, on scheme basis.

4) The Government order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above stands modified to that extent.
