<u>ORDER</u>

As per the order read above, Government have handed over the right to upkeep and maintenance obligation of "Streetscape", the city walkway facilitating Non-motorised Transport and Last Mile Connectivity in South Panampilly Nagar, Ernakulam to the Kochi Metro Rail Limited (KMRL) for a period of 5 years.

2. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Managing Director, KMRL has requested the Government to extend the handing over of the rights for upkeep and maintenance obligation of the Streetscape and the extension upto Kadavanthra Metro Station for a further period of 10 years.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to handover the rights for upkeep and maintenance obligation of the 'Streetscape' and the extension upto Kadavanthra Metro Station to the KMRL for a further period of 10 years subject to the condition that the MoU with GCDA and Kochi Corporation should specify the terms and conditions including that on who should bear the financial responsibility.
